Native Cruzers announce Sacred Site runs

In an effort to preserve "Our Sacred Places" through education, the Ho-Chunk run group, **Native Cruzers**, invites everyone to participate in three "Ho-Chunk Sacred Site" runs scheduled this July. The runs are to be held the weekends of July 15, July 22 and July 29 and organizer Willy Cleveland stated that during each run speakers will be present to explain the historical significance of each site visited. The current schedule is:

July 15- Black River Falls to LaCrosse

July 16- LaCrosse to Prairie Du Chien

July 22- Prairie Du Chien to Muscoda

July 23- Muscoda to Mendota, MN

July 29- Mendota to White Crow Village to Aztalan, WI

Many of the Sacred Sites held in reverence by Native people have been destroyed and the runs are intended to create an awareness of these sites among the public that will later lead to their being protected by government agencies. These creating an awareness of specific places is seen by Native people as a peaceful, symbolic action to remind people that they still hold sacred many of the places once inhabited by their ancestors.

It is hoped that by creating this awareness their "Sacred Sites" today's generation can leave future generations something to be proud of while at the same time honoring the lives of those who have passed on.

Per Capita Address Verification

The Office of Tribal Enrollment is preparing for the 2006 Per Capita Address Verification. The purpose is to verify all addresses used for the Per Capita Payment Distribution beginning with the August 1, 2006. All members, including members using Direct Deposit, must complete and submit an Address Verification Form (AVF). This is the official Address of Record for each tribal member until July, 2007.

Please contact the Enrollment Office, if your Address Verification Form is not received by the end of June, 2006, which will enable us to re-send an AVF.

In the event of an address change, the member must notify the Enrollment Office in writing. The notice must have the present Address of Record and the new address, with the member's name, enrollment number and Social Security Number. All Address Change Notifications must include the requestor's printed name and signature.

Tribal members electing to use Direct Deposit should apply through the Department of Treasury for depositing authorization and instructions.

Also have the manual business plan workbooks, and the user-friendly website: www.hochunkmall.com, most current compilation of Ho-Chunk Tribal member owned small businesses, as a FREE Marketing Service for Tribal members only. Business Plans submitted are scored competitively according to established criteria, highest scores are funded until the \$75,000 (Zura Honac Business Loan Fund) per quarter is exhausted. The All Nations Business Loan Fund does not currently have a limit on the number of loan amounts funded per quarterly funding cycle.

New Opportunities:

Ho-Chunk Tribal members seeking additional capital to start or expand their businesses in the six WI counties may qualify for both loan programs in a quarterly funding cycle for an allowable maximum loan amount of \$60,000.
